## GULFPORT MUNICIPAL BUILDING IN IT'S FINAL STAGES

Schmidt Consulting Group, Inc., teamed with Eley Guild Hardy Architects, Inc., in providing Mechanical, Electrical, Plumbing, Communications, and Structural design services for a new two-phase, three-story Municipal Facility to be located in downtown Gulfport, Mississippi. This facility is designed as a first responders' shelter to the standards of FEMA 361. A FEMA 361 shelter is designed and constructed to resist wind forces to 200 mph, wind-driven rain and debris impact. Also, The project is in response to the revitalization efforts of the Gulfport Main Street Association and is designed to support 25 year growth projections.

Phase I of this project includes a 57,000 square foot Police Headquarters and Municipal Courts Facility. The Police Headquarters will include: public/reception/access areas, administrative areas, the Office of the Chief, an Operations and Criminal Investigations Division, a Narcotics Division, Patrol and Traffic Operations, a Records Management Division, a Support Services Division, an Evidence Division, Information Technology, facility functional areas, facility service areas, a training center, and Information Services. The Municipal Courts Facility will include: a public lobby, security, a trial courtroom, an arraignment courtroom, judicial chambers, conference rooms, and work areas.

Phase II of this project will include 50,000 square feet of municipal services space for: Purchasing, Information Services: GIS, General Finance, Civil Service, Administrative Finance, Leisure Service, Urban Development, Courts and Court Administration, Human Resources, City Council, Utility Billing, and the City Clerk.

The construction cost of this project is approximately \$20 million and is scheduled to be complete in October 2010.



## BAHAMAS HABITAT DELIVERS



On Tuesday, January 12, the capital of Haiti was rocked by a powerful earthquake. By Saturday, and for six consecutive weekends afterwards, our Company's six-place aircraft was pressed into service assisting Bahamas Habitat by delivering medical supplies into the small towns north and west of the capital city.

Bahamas Habitat is a US-based 501c3 Christian organization dedicated to disaster assistance and promoting community. Through the end of February, this group, led by three very energetic and dedicated young people, organized more than 150 private and corporate aircraft to deliver more than 300,000 pounds of critically-needed medical supplies to the hospitals and clinics ahead of the mass migration of injured people from Port au Prince.

We took doctors from Pensacola, Atlanta and even as far away as Eugene, Oregon to serve patients in Jeremie, Les Cayes and Jacmel. We rescued a stranded church group from Jeremie and got them on their way home to St. Clair, Michigan and we reunited seven year-old Rose Angy Lee Kah Alessandra Hilarion with her mother in Pensacola after she was abandoned at the airport in Les Cayes.
